Guidelines for Pet owner

- 1. Pet ownership is the sole responsibility of the owner.
- 2. Registration of all pets that leave the owner's flat is mandatory.
- 3. Pets are strictly prohibited from defecating in the parking areas, green spaces, roads, parks, pedestrian pathways, shopping complex, entry gates, rooftops, and similar areas. Owners must carry a defecation bag when taking their pets outside.
- 4. Vaccination and immunization of each pet are mandatory, with certificates to be submitted to the maintenance office.
- 5. Pets are not allowed in the parks under any circumstances.
- 6. Pets must be leashed and accompanied by their owner or attendant when outside the flat.
- 7. Pet owners are responsible for ensuring their pets do not cause a disturbance to neighbours or other residents, including through excessive noise.
- 8. Pets are not permitted at society functions.
- 9. In the event of a pet attacking or biting a resident, the owner is responsible for covering all medical expenses for the victim.
- 10. Public displays, performances, or stunts involving pets are not allowed within the society premises.
- 11.A designated pet feeding area is available at Gate No. 3, which owners can use at their convenience.
- 12. Any incidents involving pet bites or attacks must be reported to the maintenance staff immediately.
- 13. For tenants, pet details must be included in the NOC form during the move-in process.
- 14.In case of disputes between residents, pet owners must not use their pets to intimidate or scare others.
 - Please ensure these guidelines are strictly followed to maintain a harmonious and safe environment for all residents.
